

Request for Proposal (RFP) for Grow America CoP Microsite

1. Introduction

Grow America has been selected by the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) to create and maintain a new initiative aimed at revitalizing the agency's Revolving Loan Funds (RLF) program. Our proposed five-year approach includes developing a Community of Practice (CoP) that will serve as a platform for invited participants to exchange best practices, collaborate, and document insights. We seek proposals from experienced web developers to build a microsite that will facilitate these activities.

2. Project Goals

The primary goals of the Grow America CoP Microsite are to:

- Provide a dedicated space for participants in the CoP to exchange and document best practices related to the EPA's RLF program.
- Facilitate collaboration among over 600 individuals involved in the program.
- Serve as a resource library containing relevant documents, guides, and tools.
- Ensure the microsite is operational by October 2024 to meet the requirements of the EPA grant.

3. Key Features and Functionality

The microsite must include the following key features:

- User Registration and Profiles: Allow users to create profiles and manage their information.
- Discussion Forums: Enable participants to engage in discussions, ask questions, and share insights.
- Resource Library: Provide a centralized location for documents, guides, and other resources.
- Search Functionality: Implement a robust search tool to help users quickly find relevant information.
- Collaboration Tools: Include features such as commenting, tagging, and file sharing to facilitate collaborative work.
- User Management: Admin tools to manage user permissions and content moderation.
- Responsive Design: Ensure the microsite is accessible on various devices, including desktops, tablets, and smartphones.
- Analytics and Reporting: Track user engagement and site activity to measure the effectiveness of the CoP.

4. Project Timeline

- RFP Release Date: Monday, July 29th, 2024
- Deadline to Submit Questions: No later than 12:00 p.m. PST on Thursday, August 1st, 2024.
- Proposal Submission Deadline: No later than 12:00 p.m. PST on Monday, August 5th, 2024.
- Selection of Vendor: Monday, August 12th, 2024
- Project Kickoff: Tuesday, August 13th, 2024
- Final Launch: October 1st, 2024



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5. Proposal Requirements

Proposals should include the following:

- Company Overview: Name, address, and contact details
- Brief history and background of your company
- Experience and Expertise:
 - o Examples of similar projects completed.
 - Relevant case studies and references.
- Capacity:
 - o Number of active projects underway
- Approach and Methodology:
 - o Proposed approach to the project.
 - o Project management and development methodology.
- Team: Team members who will be involved in the project, amount of time they would dedicate to this project, and their qualifications.
- Timeline: Detailed project timeline with key milestones.
- Cost: Comprehensive budget breakdown, which outlines cost(s) for potential enhancements after the CoP's implementation.

6. Evaluation Criteria

Proposals will be evaluated based on the following criteria:

- Relevant experience and expertise
- Quality and creativity of the proposed approach
- Qualifications of the project team
- Ability to meet the project timeline
- Cost-effectiveness
- References and past performance
